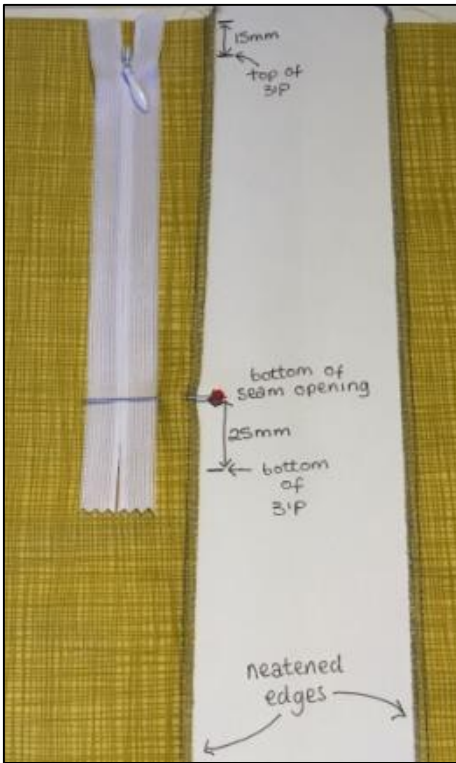


# How to insert an Invisible Zip



1. Measure and mark zip opening.

For an invisible zip you DON'T make to seam first.

## SIDE ONE:

With RS zip against RS of fabric position zip on 1.5cm line.

Pin into position.

Attach invisible zip foot & ADJUST NEEDLE POSITION.

Stitch holding line along outside edge of tape.



3. Position groove of foot over teeth and push teeth flat with finger.

Stitch close to teeth.

You may need to adjust your needle position to ensure your stitching falls in the correct place... Too close and your zip won't pull up and down easily. Too far away and the zip will show!

4. This is the first side completed.

## **SIDE TWO:**

5. Pin fabric layers together  
Match upper edges. Close zip  
and pin second side into  
position with teeth on 1.5cm  
seamline and the top of the zip  
matching the side you've just  
stitched.



6. Repeat steps 2 & 3 to secure  
second side in place.  
You may need to adjust the needle  
position again to ensure that your  
stitch fall in the correct place. You  
will use the opposite groove on  
the invisible foot for step 3

# How to insert an Invisible Zip



7. Quality Control!  
Check zip is not visible from right side. Re-stitch any sections where the zips shows or wont move easily.

## SEAM:

8. Match stitch lines at bottom of zip and pin.  
Check this from the RIGHT side to make sure you have your stitching line together and that your fabric is lying flat.



9. Change to regular zipper foot.  
Stitch on 1.5cm line to create seam. Ensure stitch line of seam matches stitch line of zip.

Stitch lower section on zip to seam allowance
