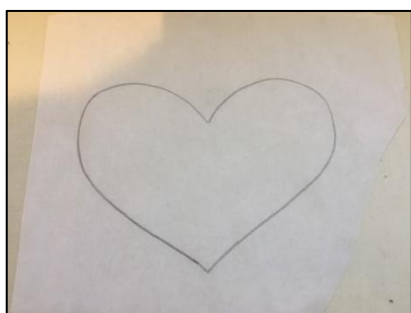


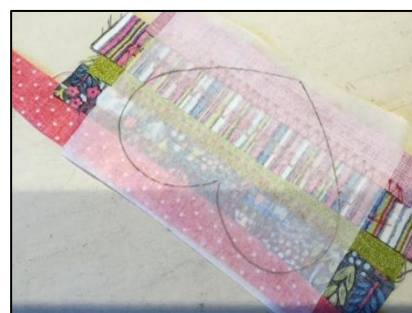
Patchwork appliqué using Bondaweb



1: Draw design on to paper side of Bondaweb



2: With glue side of Bondaweb against W.S. of fabric, lay strips of chosen fabrics over design.



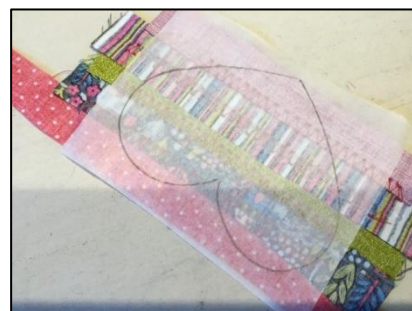
3: Cover with greaseproof paper to protect your iron. Iron Bondaweb into position using a hot iron.



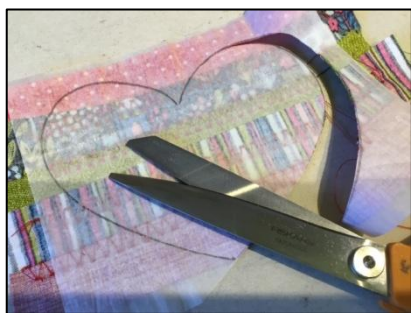
4: Carefully peel away the paper backing. The glue will hold the strips of fabric in place.



5: Select a decorative stitch or a wide zig-zag stitch to 'patchwork' the strips together. Use contrast or different colour threads to add to the decorative effect.



6: Reposition the paper backing against the glue and secure into place with a warm iron



7: Cut around your design using sharp scissors to ensure a smooth, neat edge.



8: Peel away the paper backing.



9: Position as required & iron again to secure into place. Complete by edging your design with a close zig-zag stitch
