




Caddy Section A

Cut 4 x Interfacing



OVERLAP AREA: USE TO JOIN TO SECTION C

Casing Section E
JOIN SECTIONS E & F BEFORE CUTTING OUT

Cut 2 x Main Fabric

Cut 2 x Contrast

Cut 2 Interfacing (attach to MAIN fabric)

To Complete your Fabric Caddy you will need:

30cm MAIN fabric

30cms CONTRAST fabric

10cm CONTRAST 2 for handles

60cms interfacing

Please cut out your fabric sections and attach your interfacing **BEFORE** the workshop starts.

The photo below shows the three template sections you should have once you have joined A&B and cut away the shaded areas and joined C&D.

Mark the notches on section A/B with a small 2mm cut into the edge of your fabric.
